Eligibility:

- All ages are as of January 1st 2019.
- Ages 5-18 are eligible for competition
- Entry fees must be signed by participant and parent [see attached]
- Junior Livestock Show is open to 4-H and FFA members in the following counties: Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Caldwell, Catawba, Davie, Iredell, Surry, Wilkes, and Yadkin
- Livestock includes: Beef Cattle, Goats, Sheep, and Dairy Heifers

Entry Forms and Fees:

Ages 5-18:

- **Non-refundable** \$5.00 per livestock class entered [no fees for showmanship]
- Participants can show up to the specified limit of each species [each species is eligible for showmanship]:

Sheep – 2 market lambs and 1 breeding ewe

Goats – 2 market meat goats, 1 breeding meat doe, and 2 dairy does

Please note that the Dairy Goat Show will be separate from the Meat Goat Doe Show Dairy Heifers – 2 heifers

Beef Cattle – 2 individual class of either: 2 heifers, 2 steers OR 1 heifer and 1 steer

- Wethers and Steers must be completely healed from castration
- All sheep and goats must comply with USDA and NCDA&CS Scrapie eradication Program Guidelines [valid scrapie tag or registration paper with corresponding tattoo or microchip information]
- Entry forms must be completely filled out for livestock shown [see attached]

*** RECORD BOOKS REQUIRED ***

- All youth 5-18 as of January 1, 2019 are **required** to submit a Livestock Record Book.
- Youth may choose ONE format for their record book. Complete either the Alexander Junior Livestock Show Record Book or the 4-H Project Record according to your age. The 4-H Project Record forms may be obtained from your local 4-H agent.
- If more than one species are shown, <u>only one record book, covering all species</u>, is required. Record books will be judged prior to show and returned after winners are announced.
- Record books should be up to date when they are turned in. The judges will be instructed to make allowances for plans made for the remainder of the year that have not yet been accomplished. Project stories should follow guidelines and contain information on all 4-H projects and activities.
- If you need copies of either record book format or have questions on how to complete the material, contact your local 4-H agent, DJ Salyer, at the Alexander Cooperative Extension Center at 828-632-4451.

Show Rules:

- Health papers are NOT required for this show. Animals deemed unhealthy by the show committee will be removed from the show.
- Due to a limited schedule and facilities, ALL livestock must be washed, clipped or slick shorn before coming to the show. **Exhibitors will show off the trailer.**
- Showmen are responsible to clean up the area where their livestock resided before being dismissed. Anyone leaving before being dismissed will forfeit all premiums.
- All youth are responsible for proper care of their animals. Unruly animals deemed to be a hazard to other exhibitors will be removed from the show.
- Neither the show committee nor the H&H Arena staff shall be held liable for damages related to death, injury, or loss of property incurred by or to any exhibitor of their animal. Each exhibitor shall be responsible for any damages.
- Unethical treatment of animals [determined by the show committee] will not be allowed. Practices such as slapping, tubing, etc. will be prohibited, resulting in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and premiums. No professional fitting will be allowed.
- No dogs allowed
- No alcoholic beverages allowed
